

# We work in accordance with basic humanitarian principles

The Integra Foundation is a member of the international Integral Alliance, a network of renowned humanitarian organizations. Our help is possible thanks to our local partners who operate in the affected areas.

We have been providing humanitarian aid since 2007. We follow humanitarian aid standards such as Sphere or CHS (Core Humanitarian Standards) and the way we operate is embedded in our internal policies.

In all humanitarian aid, we are guided by basic humanitarian principles, which are:

1. The principle of HUMANITY - we alleviate suffering wherever it occurs. We protect life and health with respect and reverence for people.
2. The principle of IMPARTIALITY - humanitarian action is based exclusively on the needs of people, regardless of race, nationality, gender, religion, political affiliation or social status, while we prioritize the most acute cases.
3. The principle of INDEPENDENCE - we are not subject to political, economic, military and other non-humanitarian goals.
4. The principle of NEUTRALITY - we do not favor any party in the conflict and do not engage in political, religious, racial or ideological discussions and disputes.
